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There is wide gap between the theoretical aspect and ground realities relating to Social Security Schemes in India. Employees are not provided with bare minimum benefits under these schemes. There also prevails a wide range of ignorance of these benefits among the employees. This made me to ponder and explore this topic. My stray thoughts are culminated into this work, which is blend of theoretical and empirical study.

The objective of this study is to highlight the drawbacks through empirical study in the existing systems of social security and to suggest appropriate remedy in the form of the Comprehensive Social Security Scheme. This is the crying need of the hour in the world. The Comprehensive Social Security Scheme integrates all the present social security schemes and provides complete code of benefits with smooth administrative control. A Model Bill on the Comprehensive Social Security Scheme is formulated after considering the views of the respondents.

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
