

Limitation

Of Study



- Data analysed in the present study are only from 40 patients. So it cannot be generalized. It requires larger size of sample to be studied to prove or disprove the cadiac and renal manifestations in HIV positive patients for statistical analysis.
- Only patients of lower and middle class availing services of general hospital are studied. People from higher socio-economic status could not be included in the study for unknown reasons.
- Limited essential data was available for epidemiology in patients with HIV/AIDS hence it was difficult to compare the study.
- Patients could not be subjected to thorough investigation because of financial constraints.
- Renal biopsy was not possible in HIV patients because of financial constrains.
- Diagnostic investigations like TB PCR, viral PCR, special staining procedures, HIV viral load etc. could not be done in all the patients.
- Since it was a cross sectional study follow up of patients was not possible
