- I. The present thesis is the first attempt at an allround study of the TILAKAMAÑJARI, a Sanskrit prose-romance
 of Kavi Dhanapāla of Dhārā. It, thus, serves to bring to the
 limelight a long-forgotten but highly valuable, and hence
 noteworthy Sanskrit literary master-piece, negleced by
 veteran scholars of the past, but which deserves to an
 honoured place, of which it has been unjustly deprived so
 far, in the history of Sanskrit literature.
- 2. As a study of social and cultural atmosphere reflected in the TM, it serves as a valuable fresh source-material for re-writing the detailed cultural history of India,
- 3. The present work is based mostly on the discovery of new facts and partly on the discovery of new relations of old facts, observed in passing by many a veteran scholar x so far. I have fully drawn upon allth the available sources in original and all of them have been duly acknowledged in their proper places.
