| gajahasta         | hand pose, hand held like the trunk of an elephant as in Nataraja |
| hariti saundarika | median loop   |
| kaṭi hasta        | hand pose holding the waist                                       |
| kirīṭa makuta     | conical crown with precious stones                                |
| lōla hasta        | hand pose hanging loose gracefully                                |
| makarakundala     | ear ornament like crocodile                                       |
| patra kundala     | ear ornament like leaf  |
| sama bhaṅga       | standing posture with no flexion                                  |
| sūci hasta        | hand pose pointing downwards                                      |
