SYNOPSIS

I have undertaken the work which he feels remains incomplete as my subject for Ph.D. "Reconstruction of Śańkha-Likhita Smrti withaA Critical Study ". I have afresh reconstructed Śańkha Likhita Smrti after consulting number of sources, the list of which is appended herewith,. Moreover, I have tried to study the available variants before finally reconstructing * ŚańkHA - LIKHITA SMRTI.

The reconstructed text is divided into three main divisions called Adhyayas and into topics known as prakaranas. They are as under. The figure at the end shows the number of quotations that a prakarana contains.
