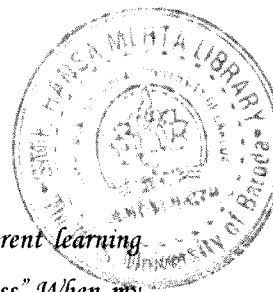


## **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT**
