Aād	= A Central horizontal pillar in the house
Āvalwali	= A horizontal pillar put breadthwise next to Aād.
Banti	= A low kind of corn
Bhāykar	= A bread of Nagli floor
Bhāt	= Rice
Bhujiyā	= A sickle like preparation
Begār	= Compulsory labour
Bānd	= A bad man
Bhagat	= A knower of 'Vidya', a witch doctor
Bāngi	= Mature
Bārik	= Young, Small
Chokhaḍi	= An ornament of ear put on by males
Dhāran	= The main central pillar of the house
Dhāria	= A weapon of sharp iron plate fixed with a long stick
Dholak	= A drum
Deli	= An upper arm ornament
Dahād	= An excursion for fishing
Dākan	= A witch.
Dandā	= A long stick
Darbhang	= An instrument for fishing

Galol	= An instrument for shooting with pebbles.
Gān̄thi	= An ornament of neck put on by married women
Fadki	= A piece of cloth used to cover head only by a mature girl
Jāt	= A village servant
Khapedo	= A wall made of bamboo strips
Kutwali	= A pillar next to Awalwali
Kar pa kadvo	= To observe a holiday
Kāp	= An ornament of ear
Kadu	= An ornament of upper hand
Kadi	= An ornament of ear
Kandorā	= An ornament of abdomen
Karbhāri	= A village secretary
Kula	= Dynasty, Endogamous group.
Khun Khadvun	= The ability of finding out a hidden coin
Madi	= An instrument for fishing
Nāgli	= A low kind of corn like Millet
Nath	= An ornament of nose
Nishni	= A public ceremony of finding out a witch
Patel	= A village head
Panch	= A village institution
Pen bharvi	= Ceremony of marriage
Rāb bharvi	= To spread the branches and burn them
Sari	= A string like ornament of neck

Thāthadi	= A bier
Varāi	= A low kind of corn
Zālar	= An ornament of ear
